- L** <sup>3</sup>to the music of the lute and the harp, to the melody of the lyre.
- C** <sup>4</sup>**For you, O LORD, have made me glad by your work; at the works of your hands I sing for joy.**
- L** <sup>5</sup>How great are your works, O LORD! Your thoughts are very deep!
- C** <sup>6</sup>**The stupid man cannot know; the fool cannot understand this:**
- L** <sup>7</sup>that though the wicked sprout like grass and all evildoers flourish, they are doomed to destruction forever;
- C** <sup>8</sup>**but you, O LORD, are on high forever.**
- L** <sup>9</sup>For behold, your enemies, O LORD, for behold, your enemies shall perish; all evildoers shall be scattered.
- C** <sup>10</sup>**But you have exalted my horn like that of the wild ox; you have poured over me fresh oil.**
- L** <sup>11</sup>My eyes have seen the downfall of my enemies; my ears have heard the doom of my evil assailants.
- C** <sup>12</sup>**The righteous flourish like the palm tree and grow like a cedar in Lebanon.**
- L** <sup>13</sup>They are planted in the house of the LORD; they flourish in the courts of our God.
- C** <sup>14</sup>**They still bear fruit in old age; they are ever full of sap and green,**
- L** <sup>15</sup>to declare that the LORD is upright; he is my rock, and there is no unrighteousness in him.

### Reading

*Romans 9:30—10:4*

**L** A reading from Romans, the ninth chapter.

<sup>30</sup>What shall we say, then? That Gentiles who did not pursue righteousness have attained it, that is, a righteousness that is by faith; <sup>31</sup>but that Israel who pursued a law that would lead to righteousness did not succeed in reaching that law. <sup>32</sup>Why? Because they did not pursue it by faith, but as if it were based on works. They have stumbled over the stumbling stone, <sup>33</sup>as it is written,

“Behold, I am laying in Zion a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offense;  
and whoever believes in him will not be put to shame.”

<sup>1</sup>Brothers, my heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved. <sup>2</sup>I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge. <sup>3</sup>For, being ignorant of the righteousness that comes from God, and seeking to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteousness. <sup>4</sup>For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

### Holy Gospel

*Luke 19:41–48*

**L** A Reading from Saint Luke, the nineteenth chapter.

<sup>41</sup>When [Jesus] drew near and saw the city, he wept over it, <sup>42</sup>saying, "Would that you, even you, had known on this day the things that make for peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes. <sup>43</sup>For the days will come upon you, when your enemies will set up a barricade around you and surround you and hem you in on every side <sup>44</sup>and tear you down to the ground, you and your children within you. And they will not leave one stone upon another in you, because you did not know the time of your visitation."

<sup>45</sup>And he entered the temple and began to drive out those who sold, <sup>46</sup>saying to them, "It is written, 'My house shall be a house of prayer,' but you have made it a den of robbers."

<sup>47</sup>And he was teaching daily in the temple. The chief priests and the scribes and the principal men of the people were seeking to destroy him, <sup>48</sup>but they did not find anything they could do, for all the people were hanging on his words.
